Beaumaris Reserve Sports Ground Car Parking

Bayside City Council has developed a concept plan for the car parking and access road adjacent to the sports ground consistent with Councils endorsed Beaumaris Reserve Masterplan (2008).

The Masterplan recognises that Beaumaris Reserve is a popular area of open space and seeks to improve the current facilities to better meet the needs of the existing sports clubs, community groups and residents.

This is a heavily used car park. Particularly during the winter months around 4000 vehicle per week use this facility. Due to this high volume of vehicular movements the existing surface remains in a constant state of deterioration. As a result it is proposed that the car park be sealed.

The proposed plan includes:

- Parking bays for 23 cars including one reserved space for people with special needs
- Asphalt surfaces for the parking area and the access road
- Drainage, including rain garden
- Two separate pathways from the pavilion to the sports ground for two competing teams

Please note that implementation of this project will require removal of six trees as marked in the proposed plan printed overleaf.
