**Sunday 6th March 2011 from 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.**

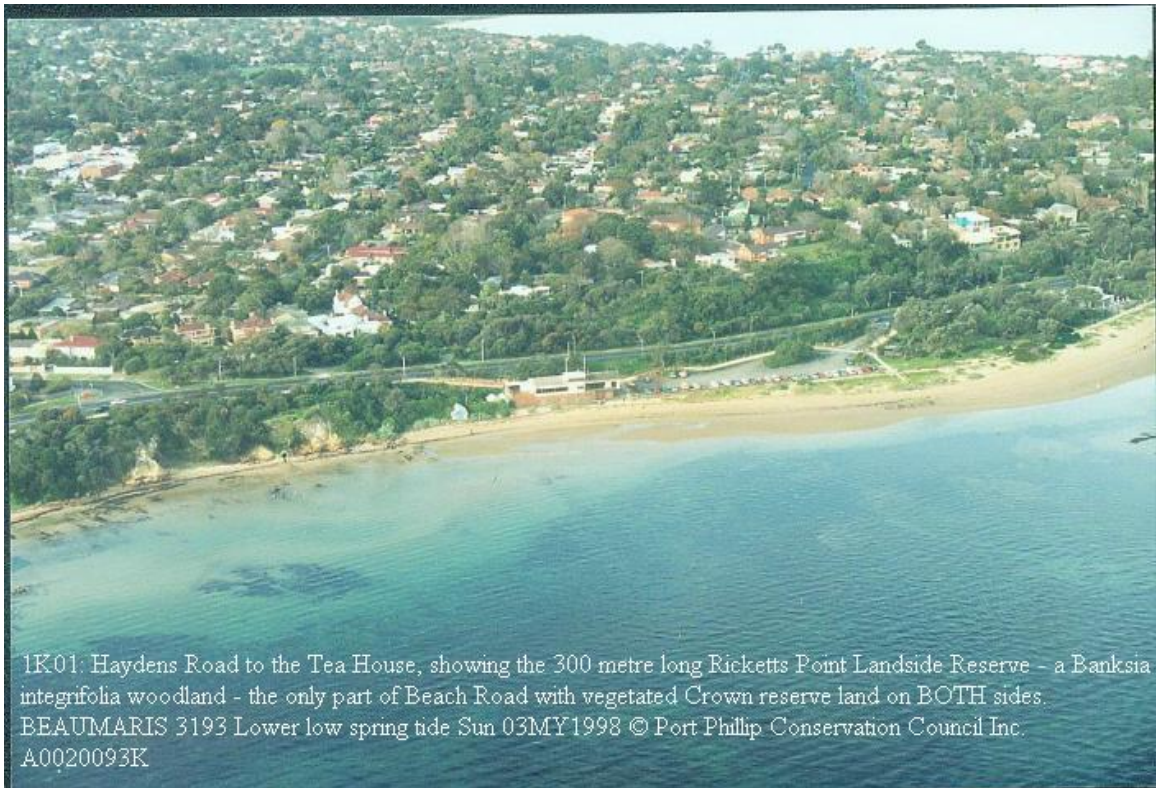
**Meet on the opposite side of the road from the Ricketts Point Tea House,
