just east of the pedestrian crossing.**

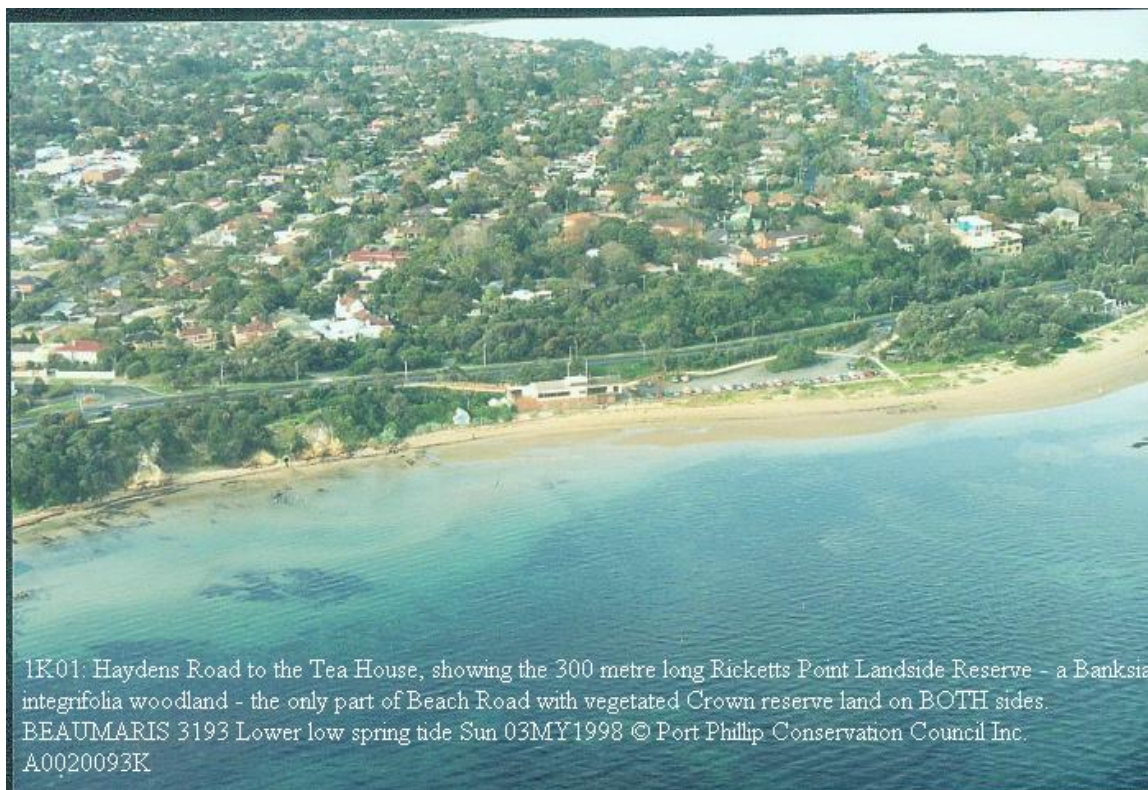
Sun hat, sunscreen, gloves and sturdy shoes are required, please.
